(Service Leader welcomes people to church and introduces people involved in the service)

Helping me in today's service are our musicians Rosemary and Young-Lan. Reading to us from the Bible will be Lynn, leading us in prayer is Rosemary, and Trevor will bring our Bible teaching.

We here at Abbotsford Anglican Church are a group of local people of all ages and backgrounds who have come to find meaning and purpose for life by living life God's way according to his word the Bible. We invite you to know God with us.

GATHERING IN GOD'S NAME

We have met together to thank God, to meet with Jesus, and to encourage one another while we wait for Christ's return. We shall praise God with our words and by what we do. We shall hear from his holy word and we shall pray for the Church and for all people.

OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, you have brought us here today. This time we meet with you and your people is special. Help us not to take this moment with you and your people for granted. May we listen to your word with expectation, engage in what we pray and say, and worship you with all our heart, mind, soul and strength through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

BAPTISM - Trevor

Words on the screen

God is the source of everything that is good. Children are his gift and he entrusts parents with the privilege and responsibility of nurturing them in his way. God wants our children to experience a loving home, to gain wisdom, to live generously for the good of all, to grow in faith, and to come at last to share in his eternal kingdom.

Jesus said: 'Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.

Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it.'

Without Christ, we humans are far gone from God and trapped in our sin. Through the gospel, God addresses each one of us and calls us back to himself, resulting in a profound change. The act of baptism is about that change.

We follow the direction of Jesus, who said, 'Go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.'

Ordinary water is used to point to the extraordinary work of God in cleansing us from sin and giving us a new heart to trust and serve him, through the death and resurrection of his Son. Baptism provides a public opportunity to turn to Christ and express a personal trust in him and what he has done for us, and to ask for the renewing work of the Holy Spirit.

Jesus taught that none can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit. 'Flesh gives birth to flesh,' he said, 'but the Spirit gives birth to spirit'.

So let us pray to God the Father through our Lord Jesus Christ that he will grant to Poppy and Quinton what they cannot have by nature, that they may be born again by the Holy Spirit and be made living members of Christ's Church. Heavenly Father, we thank you that in your great love you have called us to know you and to trust you. Increase this knowledge and strengthen our faith.

Grant that Poppy and Quinton may be born again by the Holy Spirit, cleansed from all sin, and inherit your eternal kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

The minister invites the sponsors to stand with the child to be baptised and says to them.

God promises forgiveness and the gift of the Holy Spirit to all who turn to him in Christ. This promise also embraces the children of God's people, whom we bring to him in faith. Children must themselves express faith in Christ when they are able to do so. They must turn away from sin and put their trust in him. In due course, they should come to reaffirm these promises and receive prayer for strengthening in confirmation.

Those of you who already trust in Christ, and are willing to teach and encourage Poppy and Quinton in the same faith, are invited to make the baptismal promises on her behalf. Therefore, I ask you,

Are you yourself a follower of Jesus Christ, trusting the gracious promises of God?

I am.

Are you willing to sponsor Poppy and Quinton, answering for them now and accepting responsibility for their Christian upbringing in the life of the Church? I am willing.

I now ask to answer on behalf of Poppy and Quinton.

Do you turn to Christ? I turn to Christ.

Do you repent of your sins? I repent of my sins.

Do you reject selfish living and all that is false and unjust?

I reject them all.

Do you renounce Satan and all evil? I renounce all that is evil.

Almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, and lead you in the light of Christ to his everlasting kingdom. **Amen.**

Poppy and Quinton have been brought here for baptism. Let us all affirm the faith into which they are to be baptised. Please stand. Together...

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ. God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again from the dead: he ascended into heaven. and is seated at the right hand of the Father: from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic* church, the communion of saints. the forgiveness of sins,

the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

*catholic = "of the whole," universal, complete

The minister says to the sponsors

I ask you to answer on behalf of Poppy and Quinton. Do you affirm this faith as yours?

I do.

Will you follow Jesus faithfully, and obey his commands throughout your life? With God's help, I intend to do so.

Do you ask for baptism in the faith you have affirmed?

I do.

Congregation sits. Parents and Godparents move to the font with the child, the minister says.

Let us pray.

Merciful God, for Jesus Christ's sake, grant that Poppy and Quinton whom we baptise in this water, may be saved through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit. May they die to sin and rise again to righteousness. May your Spirit live and work in them, that they may be yours forever; through Jesus Christ our Lord who died and rose again for us. **Amen.**

The minister says to the parents of the child Name this child.

Then the minister baptises the child, saying

Poppy Joy Harris/Quinton Robert Harris, I baptise you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

After the child has been baptised the minister and congregation together address them.

God has called you into his church. We therefore receive and welcome you as a fellow member of the body of Christ, as a child of the same heavenly Father, and as an inheritor with us of the kingdom of God.

The minister makes a sign of the cross on the child's forehead and says

I sign you with the sign of the cross to show that you are to be true to Christ crucified and that you are not to be ashamed to confess your faith in him. Fight bravely under his banner against sin, the world and the devil, and continue Christ's faithful soldier and servant to your life's end.

God has called you out of darkness into his marvellous light.

Shine as a light in the world to the glory of God the Father.

The minister invites all to pray.

Gracious God, we thank you that through the death and resurrection of your Son, you have brought us from death to life. Enable us by your Spirit to resist the power of sin and give ourselves to you as a living sacrifice. May we not be conformed to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of our mind, so that we serve and please you in every way. Amen.

A Prayer for the Parents - Rosemary

Heavenly Father, we pray for Poppy and Quinton's parents Emily and Guy, and for

their godparents. Give them the spirit of wisdom and love, that they may teach her by word and example to fulfil the promises made in her name. In our homes, give us the joy that comes from being faithful followers of the Lord Jesus Christ. **Amen.**

BIBLE READING – Lynn

Luke 18:15-33

¹⁵ People were also bringing babies to Jesus for him to place his hands on them. When the disciples saw this, they rebuked them. ¹⁶ But Jesus called the children to him and said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. ¹⁷ Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it."

¹⁸ A certain ruler asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

¹⁹ "Why do you call me good?" Jesus answered. "No one is good—except God alone. ²⁰ You know the commandments: 'You shall not commit adultery, you shall not murder, you shall not steal, you shall not give false testimony, honour your father and mother.'"

²¹ "All these I have kept since I was a boy," he said.

²² When Jesus heard this, he said to him, "You still lack one thing. Sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

²³ When he heard this, he became very sad, because he was very wealthy.
²⁴ Jesus looked at him and said, "How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God! ²⁵ Indeed, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God."

²⁶ Those who heard this asked, "Who then can be saved?"

²⁷ Jesus replied, "What is impossible with man is possible with God."

²⁸ Peter said to him, "We have left all we had to follow you!"

²⁹ "Truly I tell you," Jesus said to them, "no one who has left home or wife or brothers or sisters or parents or children for the sake of the kingdom of God ³⁰ will fail to receive many times as much in this age, and in the age to come eternal life." ³¹ Jesus took the Twelve aside and told them, "We are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written by the prophets about the Son of Man will be fulfilled. ³² He will be delivered over to the Gentiles. They

will mock him, insult him and spit on him; ³³ they will flog him and kill him. On the third day he will rise again." (NIV)

BIBLE TEACHING – Trevor
